

Former Lahey Fellow Wins Award

Anne Gonzalez, M.D., won the young investigators award at the Annual International Meeting of the American College of Chest Physicians (CHEST 2008) in Philadelphia in October 2008 for her paper "Acute lung injury following thoracoscopic talc insufflation," based on her research during her interventional pulmonology fellowship at Lahey Clinic. She is now on staff at McGill University.

Finalists were evaluated on the basis of their written abstract and their presentations at [CHEST 2008](#). Award recipients were selected for their outstanding original scientific research by judges from the Scientific Presentations and Awards Committee.
