LODGING INFORMATION

Ocean Edge is located at 2907 Main Street, Brewster (Cape Cod), Massachusetts. It is a one and one-half to two hour drive from Boston, or a 12-mile drive from the Barnstable/Hyannis Airport, which has daily air service from New York, Hartford, and Boston. In addition to being an excellent conference facility, Ocean Edge offers multiple recreation activities, including a championship golf course, tennis courts, swimming pools, exercise rooms, and biking and jogging trails.

DIRECTIONS TO OCEAN EDGE

Pick up Route 6 (Mid-Cape Highway) at the end of the Sagamore Bridge and follow Route 6 to the Brewster/Harwich Exit, #10. Turn left onto Route 124 and follow to the intersection of Route 6A (approximately 10 minutes). Turn right on 6A East. From this point, it is 1.8 miles to Ocean Edge Resort and Conference Center. Check in is available on both the golf course and ocean sides of the property.
