PGY2 Ambulatory Care Pharmacy Residency Program

PROGRAM DESIGN

The curriculum for the program is comprised of longitudinal, quarterly rotations, where residents spend half-days or full days each week in various learning experiences.

LEARNING EXPERIENCES (all are longitudinal)

Required:

- Orientation (first 4 weeks)
- Primary care (2-4 half-days/week, year round)
- Staffing in the outpatient pharmacy (6 hours/week, year round)
- Practice Management (year round)
- Research (year round)
- Anticoagulation (1 day/week for 3 months)
- Heart Failure (1 day/week for 3 months)
- Pulmonary Clinic (1 half-day/week for 3-6 months)
- Specialty Pharmacy (1 day/week for 3 months)

Elective:

- Hematology/Oncology
- Informatics
- Palliative Care
- Population Health
- Solid Organ Transplant
- Additional experience in any core rotation

Additional Responsibilities:

- Teaching
- Committee work
- Interprofessional presentations
- Educational Conference Attendance
- Vaccine Administration (staffing & in clinic)
- General Internal Medicine Staff meetings
